Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q: What is Dentrix Learning Edition?

A: Dentrix Learning Edition is a limited, trial version of Dentrix and a collection of online lessons—an ideal learning solution for motivated, independent learners.

Q: How much does Dentrix Learning Edition cost?

A: Dentrix Learning Edition is available for download at no cost. Registration is required.

Q: Where can I download Dentrix Learning Edition?

A: Visit https://learningedition.dentrix.com to register and download Dentrix Learning Edition. If you are inexperienced at downloading or installing software, ask a friend to help you.

Q: How is the Dentrix Learning Edition software different from the Dentrix software used in dental practices?

- A: All of the major Dentrix features are available in the Learning Edition, but the Learning Edition software has three key limitations:
 - Database—Dentrix Learning Edition uses a restricted database with a fictional practice, 11 fictional healthcare providers, and 73 fictional patients. Learners cannot change the practice or provider information. Learners can add new patients, but only until the database reaches 100 patients.
 - Networking—Dentrix Learning Edition is designed for use by a single learner on a single computer. The database cannot be shared on a network of computers.
 - Procedure Codes and Claim Forms—Dentrix Learning Edition does not include any copyrighted procedure codes or claim forms. Fictional codes and generic forms are provided instead.

Q: What are the system requirements for Dentrix Learning Edition?

A: At a minimum, you'll need a 4-core processor running at 2.4 GHz, 8 GB of RAM, 40 GB of disk space (5 GB on the C: drive), and Windows 7 Sp1*, Windows 8.1, or Windows 10. Exceeding the minimum standards may result in better system performance. Complete system requirements are available at http://hsps.pro/dentrixlearningedition/systemregs.pdf.

*Note: Microsoft discontinued support for Windows 7. This operating system will work with Dentrix G7.3 but is not recommended since it no longer receives security updates.

Q: I am using anti-virus software on my computer. Will that cause problems when I install Dentrix Learning Edition?

A: Yes. Some anti-virus programs mistakenly detect the Dentrix installation files as viruses and can delete important installation files. You should disable any anti-virus software on your computer before installing Dentrix Learning Edition and then re-enable your antivirus software immediately after the installation.

- A: Yes, but you cannot network it and the database is limited. Dentrix Learning Edition is meant for individual learners to install on their own computers. - Q: Can I upgrade Dentrix Learning Edition to the unrestricted, commercial version of Dentrix?
- A: No. Dentrix Learning Edition and the commercial version of Dentrix are separate products.
