EASY DAY PLANNING

Many practice management consultants advocate a strategy of scheduling just the right balance of high production, medium production, and low production procedures. Easy Dental helps achieve that balance by allowing you to reserve certain times during the day by blocking those times for scheduling of specific procedure types (i.e., high production, low production, etc.).

APPOINTMENT TYPES

The first step in setting this up in Easy Dental is to create appointment types. These types can then be assigned to procedures, time blocks, and appointments to set them apart. Listed below are the four appointment types that are installed with Easy Dental. **You can add up to 10 in your database.** You may make changes to the types listed in the column to the right of the existing description or add your own. Once these types are entered into Easy Dental, you will be able to assign them to procedures. (See Procedure Code Setup to assign a specific appointment type to a procedure.)

Because changing a definition will affect everything it is assigned to, you should make sure that everything is set up the way you want it to be in the very beginning. This will help eliminate in problems in the future that may occur because of changing and existing definition.



Because time blocks can be used to block out time when a provider is out of the office or an operatory is closed, you may want to create an appointment type called, Out of the Office. When this appointment type is assigned to a time block, this will allow Easy Dental to warn anyone scheduling an appointment in an "Out of the Office" time block that they are scheduling an appointment that does not match the time block. This can help your staff pay more attention when scheduling appointments, so that they do not accidentally schedule an appointment when they should not.

TIME BLOCKS

A time block allows you to block times in the Schedule module for certain appointment types and providers (i.e. high production, low production, crowns, meetings, etc.). Once Easy Day Planning has been set up and activated, you see a colored border with the time block name and the provider assigned to that block. Anyone attempting to schedule an appointment with an appointment type not matching the blocked time is warned and asked if they want to override the warning. **You can set up six time blocks for each provider within Easy Dental.**

There are six time block forms provided. Make copies for each provider. There are also two examples of time blocks below. One illustrates a time block for crowns and another illustrates a time block for being out of the office.

RECALL

Recall is the system in Easy Dental designed to keep track of recurring patient visits. Each patient can be assigned to one or more recall types with a due date range attached that can be updated automatically. This range can be individualized per patient or left as the default. (Ask your trainer or call Support to find out how to individualize the interval for a patient.)

In Easy Dental, you can attach a recall type to procedures, so that when those procedures are completed, the due date is automatically updated for the patient.

Below are the recall types that are currently in the Easy Dental database. At the end of the list, there are also some blanks that you can use to add more recall types if you would like.

BILLING TYPES

Billing types are assigned to families to help categorize them in Easy Dental. For example, finance charges need only apply to certain families. Therefore, you can assign those families one of the billing types for finance charges. Currently, there are nine billing types that are setup in the database. **However, up to 99 types may be added to the database.**

Below are the current billing types and their descriptions. Blank cells are provided to add your own billing types and descriptions. You may also change the existing ones by entering the new description in the column to the right of the current description. You can use any kind of description that will set one family apart from another.

MEDICAL ALERTS

Medical alerts notify your practice as to a patient's medical status. Currently, 49 medical alerts are set up in the database **with a maximum capability of 64**. Below are the medical alerts currently in the system. Medical alerts can be changed or added according to your preference. If you would like to change an existing alert, simply enter the new description into the column to the right of the existing description.



Even though the medical alerts may not be listed alphabetically in Definitions, they will be listed alphabetically in the Patients module. By putting an asterisk in front of a description, Easy Dental will sort that alert at the top of the list.

EXPLOSION CODES

Explosion codes are five-character codes that will post one or more procedures at a time. They can also be created to always post procedures with certain surfaces or quadrants. All explosion codes begin with the “xx” prefix. Decide on an explosion code name and then attach up to eight procedures, including other explosion codes, to that code.

Currently, there are 10 explosion codes already set up in the database. Listed below are the currently explosion codes in the database as well as a few examples of what explosion codes can do. Then, two standard and two bridge explosion code templates are available for you to add more if you would like.



Easy Dental knows when you post a procedure to an anterior or posterior tooth and will make sure that a posterior code is used when posting to a posterior tooth and an anterior code is used when posting to an anterior tooth. So, it does not matter which code you attach to the explosion code as Easy Dental will always change it to the correct one if necessary. (This is also the case with the number of surfaces being posted.)

xxREA	Recall - Prophy, Adult	Will allow you to post an adult prophy, four bitewings, and a periodic oral evaluation all at once.			
xxREC	Recall - Comprehensive	Not only will this explosion code allow you to post an adult prophy, four bitewings, and a periodic oral evaluation all at once, it will also post a pulp vitality test, collection of microorganism culture, caries susceptibility test, and a complete bitewings series.			
xxREP	Recall - Prophy, Child	Will allow you to post a child prophy, two bitewings, and a periodic oral evaluation all at once.

SCHEDULE MODULE DEFINITIONS

There are two definitions types that pertain to the Schedule module: Appointment Reasons and Appointment Statuses.

APPOINTMENT REASONS

Appointment reasons are shortcut procedures that can be assigned to appointments using the Initial button. Using these appointment reasons can save time in scheduling. Below are the 20 Easy Dental defaults. **You can have up to 20 in the database.**

You can change the existing appointment reasons by entering the new code in the column to the right of the existing code and a new description in the column to the right of the existing description. You can also use an explosion code and any procedure that does not require a tooth number, surface, or additional information when posted.

PROCEDURE CODE SETUP

In this area, you can customize each procedure in the database to fit the needs of your practice. You will have the ability to add procedure codes to each category if desired, change the existing abbreviated description, set up the time units, select an appointment type, choose the treatment area of the procedure, choose whether or not this procedure is a difficult procedure, and whether or not it should be billed to insurance.

Time units are equal to the time increments that are being used in the Schedule module. For example, if your appointments are broken into 10-minute increments, three time units would equal 30 minutes. Enter the number of time units to be assigned to each procedure in the U column. In Easy Dental, you will be able to decide how each time unit will be used (i.e., chair time, assistant time, and doctor time).

The appointment type choices in your database will correspond directly with the appointment types that you set up during the Easy Day Planning section in this worksheet.

The treatment area will determine whether or not Easy Dental will ask for additional information, such as tooth number, quadrant, sextant, etc. when a procedure is posted. Most of the codes are already setup with the proper treatment area. However, some offices do like to change the areas for some procedures. If you would like to change the treatment area for a procedure, simply enter the change in the row underneath the existing treatment area. Your choices are, Surface, Tooth, Mouth, Root, Quadrant, and Sextant.

The treatment flags allow you to determine whether or not a procedure will appear in the category buttons in the Chart module, which should be restricted to procedures that are most often performed in your practice, as well as determine whether or not a call should be made to the patient at the end of the day because they had a difficult procedure performed. Your choices are:

- **Difficult Procedure:** This will print an asterisk next to the patient's phone number on the Day Sheet indicating that a follow up call should be made to them at the end of the day. In the Tx Flags column, enter a DP if the procedure should be marked as a difficult procedure.
- **Condition:** This will turn the procedure code into a condition, which will not allow you to treatment plan or complete the procedure. This should be reserved for things like, recession, fractured tooth, etc. In the Tx Flags column, enter a C if the procedure should be marked as a condition.
- **Remove Tooth:** This will remove the tooth from the tooth chart whenever the procedure is posted. In the Tx Flags column, enter a R if the procedure should remove the tooth when it is posted in a patient's account.
- **Show in Chart:** If this is checked, then this procedure will show in its corresponding category list in the Chart module. If this is not checked, then it will not be listed. You should only check this for the procedures that are performed most often in your practice, so that this list is kept to one page making it easy to find the procedures. (If you need to post a procedure that is not listed, you can manually search for the procedure in the Chart.) In the Tx Flags column, enter a SC if the procedure should be listed in its corresponding category list in the Chart module.

If you have any procedures that should never be billed to insurance, there is an option in Easy Dental that allows you to indicate this. For example, if you add a code for toothbrush, you will not want to bill that to insurance, so if you check Do Not Bill to Insurance, Easy Dental will not attach this code to a claim when the procedure code is posted to a patient's account. If there are any codes that should not be billed, simply place a checkmark in the No Ins column.
